A blessed and happy Trinity Sunday to you!

As you all know, this is a very big week for our diocese. On Wednesday, 29 May 2024, Bishop-elect Michael Martin will be ordained as the 5th Bishop of Charlotte at St. Mark Catholic Church in Huntersville. He will be installed in the Cathedral of St. Patrick the following day. This is going to be a big change for Bishop-elect Martin, as well as a big change for our diocese. So please pray that Bishop-elect Martin will be exactly the bishop our diocese needs.

To this end, please remember that we are having our annual 40 Hours Celebration this week. To help ease Bishop Martin's transition into the episcopacy and into the Diocese of Charlotte, we are going to offer our 40 Hours Celebration for him. Our 40

Hours celebration will begin on Thursday, 30 May 2024, with a Latin Mass at 7pm. Adoration will begin immediately after Mass and will continue until the afternoon of Saturday, 01 June 2024. We'll complete our Corpus Christi celebration with our annual Eucharistic procession after the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, 02 June 2024. This year's diaconate ordination will be at 10am on Saturday, 01 June 2024, while the priestly ordination will be on Saturday, 15 June 2024, at 10am. Both ordinations will also take place at St. Mark's in Huntersville, and they are open to the public. Please pray for all the men receiving the Sacrament of Holy Orders!

Speaking of ordinations, this year I am celebrating the 20th anniversary of my priestly ordination. It's been my joy to spend 17 of those 20 years right here at St. Ann's. To celebrate, I will be offering our normal 6pm Latin Mass on Wednesday, 05 June 2024, as a Mass of Thanksgiving. The Mass will be immediately followed by a public reception in the Allen Center.
