Dear Parishioners,

For those of you who read the Friday 5 bulletin blast, you know that I've asked you to pray a 54-day Rosary Novena in preparation for the upcoming election, which should have begun this past Friday. Of course, I'm sure our Lord will honor your intentions if you begin today, even though you're starting late. Pray the Holy Rosary daily that God's will may be done with the upcoming election. But also pray for the respect and protection of life in all its stages; for the sanctity of marriage and families; for the upholding of constitutionally protected religious freedom; and for a return of our nation to God and holiness. And, we should pray for peace in our world.

To pray a 54-day Rosary Novena is simple. Simply pray the Holy Rosary for 54 consecutive days for the intentions stated above, entrusting these petitions to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. But in addition to praying, I also encourage you to fast from something, just like we do in Lent. Fasting puts muscle on our prayers. It's a way for us to demonstrate to God how

serious we are about our prayer intention. So please consider giving up something during the 54 days of the Rosary Novena. Our Lady can do much with our prayer and fasting when we turn to her with a confident faith and humility, especially when we've consecrated ourselves to her.

Some of you may also know that the exorcist, Fr. Chad Ripperger, has penned a prayer for the upcoming election. I heartily encourage you to pray this as well. Fr. Ripperger's prayer is:

Mary Immaculate, living tabernacle of the Divinity, where the eternal Wisdom lies hidden to be adored and served by angels and men; Queen of Heaven and Earth, beneath whose sway are subject all things that are subject to God; Patroness of the United States of America, sorrowful and mindful of our own sinfulness and the sins of our nation, we come to thee, our refuge and hope. Knowing that our country cannot be saved by our own works and mindful of how much our nation has departed from the ways of thy Son, we humbly ask that thou wouldst turn thine eyes upon our country to bring about its conversion.

We consecrate to thee the integrity of the upcoming election and its outcome, so that what is spiritually and morally best for the citizens of our country may be accomplished, and that all of those who are elected would govern according to the spiritual and moral principles which will bring our nation into conformity with the teachings of thy Son.

Give grace to the citizens of this land so that they will choose leaders according to the Sacred Heart of thy Son, that His glory may be made manifest, lest we be given the leaders we deserve. Trusting in the providential care of God the Father and thy maternal care, we have perfect confidence that thou wilt take care of us and will not leave us forsaken. O Mary Immaculate, pray for us. Amen.

We all know that there's a lot at stake in the upcoming election. Let's pray hard that God's will may be done for our country.


