This pastoral plan detailing the state of the parish and our pastoral needs and priorities has just been submitted to the Diocese. At the end of October, several parish leaders and I will spend a day at the diocesan offices to review our pastoral plan with diocesan leadership (and hopefully get approval for it!). I am exceedingly grateful to the outstanding work done by our Parish Council under the very capable and expeditious leadership of our chairman, Rick Taylor. Rick and our council members have put in many, many hours of work on this project, and we all owe them a debt of gratitude.

What is the Catholic perspective on infertility and assisted reproductive technologies like IVF?

Learn more by exploring resources from the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) below:

<u>Life-Giving Love in an Age of Technology</u> uses a question-and-answer format to address the suffering of infertility, how Catholic couples can respond, and the problems with the use of donors, surrogates, IVF, and other reproductive technologies.

In Vitro Fertilization: The Human Cost outlines the risks associated with IVF, including high death rates for embryos, health risks for women and the children conceived by this procedure, and "mixups" and errors that harm families.

Letter to the U.S. Senate (Feb, 2024) from the U.S. bishops outlining the threats to life, family integrity, and religious freedom in recent legislative efforts to create a "right to IVF."
