Dear Parishioners,

This month of October is quickly coming to an end, and so it's time to begin thinking about our deceased loved ones, whom we will honor next month. As we have for the past several years, we will be offering a Novena of Masses for all the Poor Souls in Purgatory. If you would like to have your deceased loved ones remembered in a special way, please use the **All Souls envelopes** and write the names of your loved ones on the envelope. You may turn in your envelopes at any time during the month of November. Those listed on the envelopes will also be remembered in a special *Litany of the Dead* that we will offer after every daily Mass during November. If you make your donation

online, be sure to put your All Souls envelope in the collection with the names of your deceased loved ones, or send us an email with those names. The Book of the Dead will also be available in the narthex for you to list the names of your beloved deceased for whom you desire prayers.

Please keep in mind that an **indulgence** is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the dead (even if the prayer is only mental) during the first 8 days of November. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is also granted to the faithful, who piously visit a church or a public oratory on All Souls Day. In visiting the church or oratory, it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited. Both of these indulgences are granted under the normal conditions, i.e., one must be baptized and in the state of grace, be free from an attachment to sin, go to confession within 20 days, receive Holy Communion on the day you visit the cemetery or church, and offer prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (a *Creed* and an *Our Father* will suffice).

Next Sunday we are having a very special event after the 12:30 Mass: our annual **Eucharistic Procession** in honor of Christ the King. While the Feast of Christ the King is celebrated as the Last Sunday in Ordinary Time in the new calendar of the Church, in the Latin Mass calendar it is celebrated on the last Sunday in October. Immediately after the 12:30 Mass, we will have the Eucharistic Procession. Please join us as we pray for our nation and give glory and honor to Christ our King!

And don't forget the Carnival on 02 November! We will have a special All Souls Day Mass at 9am. The carnival will begin at 10am!

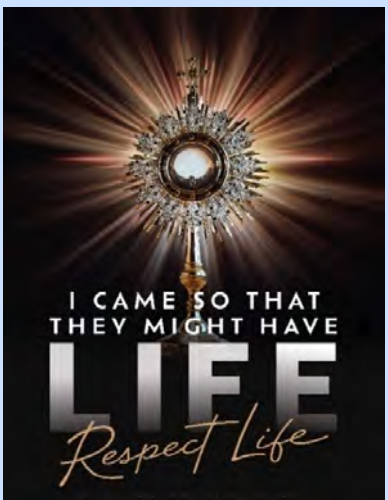

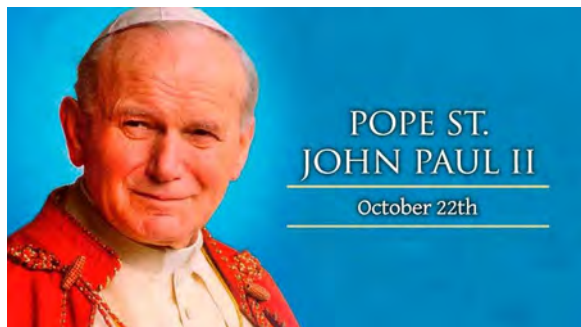

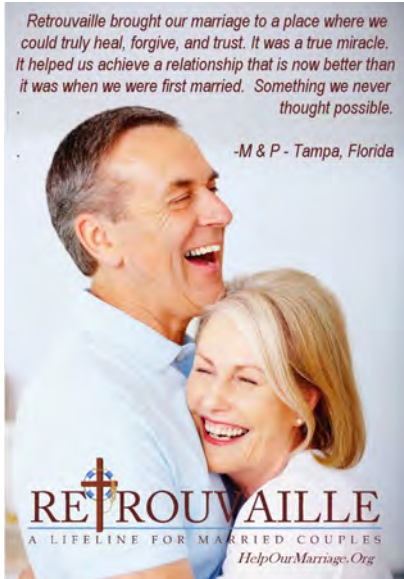
