Dear Parishioners,



I am grateful to all of you who attended our All Souls Day Mass this weekend. While not a holy day of obligation like All Saints Day, it's a very important day to attend Mass, for praying for the poor souls in Purgatory is a duty of all Catholics. To this end, if

you would like to have your deceased loved ones remembered in a special way, please use the All Souls **envelopes** and write the names of your loved ones on the envelope. They will be remembered in the novena of Masses this month for all the dead, and in a special Litany of the Dead that we are offering after every daily Mass during November. You may turn in your envelopes at any time this month (if you haven't done so already) by dropping them into any Mass collection, by dropping them off at the office, or by using the online donation page on our website. If you make your donation online, be sure to put your All Souls envelope in the collection with the names of your deceased loved ones, or send us an email with those names. The Book of the Dead is also available in the narthex for you to list the names of your beloved deceased for whom you desire prayers.


Please keep in mind that an **indulgence** is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the dead (even if the prayer is only mental) during the first 8 days of November. This indulgence is granted under the normal conditions, i.e., one must be baptized and in the state of grace, be free from an attachment to sin, go to confession within 20 days, receive Holy Communion on the day you visit the cemetery or church, and offer prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (a *Creed* and an *Our Father* will suffice). For those of you who are interested, a group of parishioners will be gathered for prayer at Belmont Abbey Cemetery this Sunday, 03 November 2024, at 3 p.m.

Lastly, thank you for supporting our Carnival this weekend! This event is only successful because so many of you pitch in to help out, and I'm grateful for that. And the fact that the Carnival brings together the whole parish makes it a beautiful day, no matter what the actual weather is! Many thanks to Eric Kashmanian (our Carnival Committee Chairman), his family, and our entire Carnival Committee for all their hard work!




