The **National Right to Life March** is this Friday, 24 January 2025, in Washington, D.C. I hope that some of you will attend. As we prepare to mark the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade* and prepare for the National Right to Life March, let us all take on a few

extra penances to make reparation for the terrible sin of abortion.

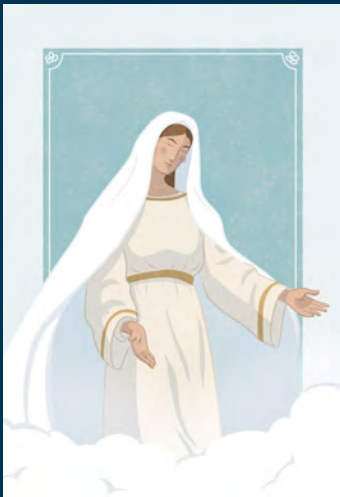

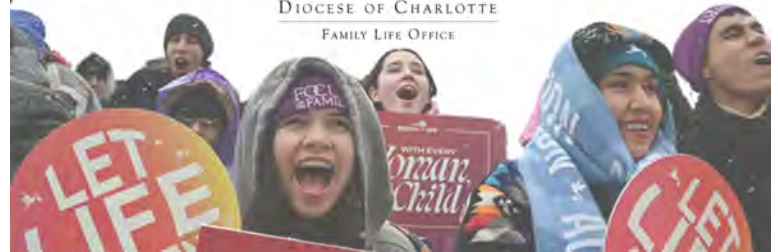
