## Dear Parishioners,



Many thanks to all of you who were able to attend the March for Life in Washington, DC this past Friday. It's always good to see so many of our parishioners at the North Carolina Pilgrims' Mass celebrated by our North

Carolina bishops on the morning of the March. Again, I apologize for not being able to find coverage for all our Masses while I was away. Unfortunately, we are stretched very thin with our priests in the diocese right now – which is why we lost Fr. Jones to Swannanoa. Please pray that we will continue having many young men enter the seminary in the years to come!

Next Sunday is a special day in the liturgical life of the Church. Instead of the 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time (or the 4th Sunday after Epiphany in the Latin Mass), we will be celebrating **Candlemas**, which is a feast day also known as the Presentation of the Lord (Novus Ordo Masses) or the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Latin Mass). This is one of the oldest feasts in the liturgical calendar, and we know its roots stretch back at least to the early 4th century. With this feast we come to the end of the Christmas Cycle in the liturgy. This feast is called Candlemas because on this feast day the candles used at Mass for the upcoming year traditionally are blessed. It's also appropriate to bless candles for your personal use at home on this day, so please feel free to bring any candles you wish to have blessed for your home. We will be blessing candles at the very beginning of each of the

Masses.

I also have some very good news to share with you: St. Ann's is getting another deacon! Deacon Ari Lekovic, who was ordained in 2017 in the Archdiocese of New York but moved to our parish last year, has now been formally assigned to us. You'll begin seeing our new deacon serving at our Masses this weekend. Please be sure to welcome him.

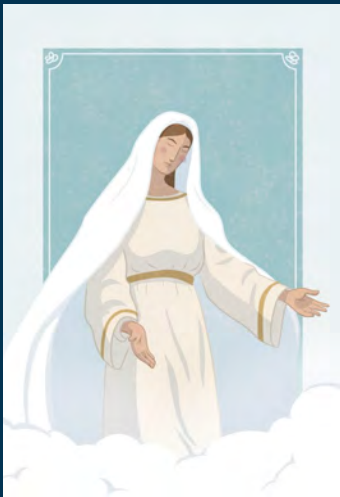

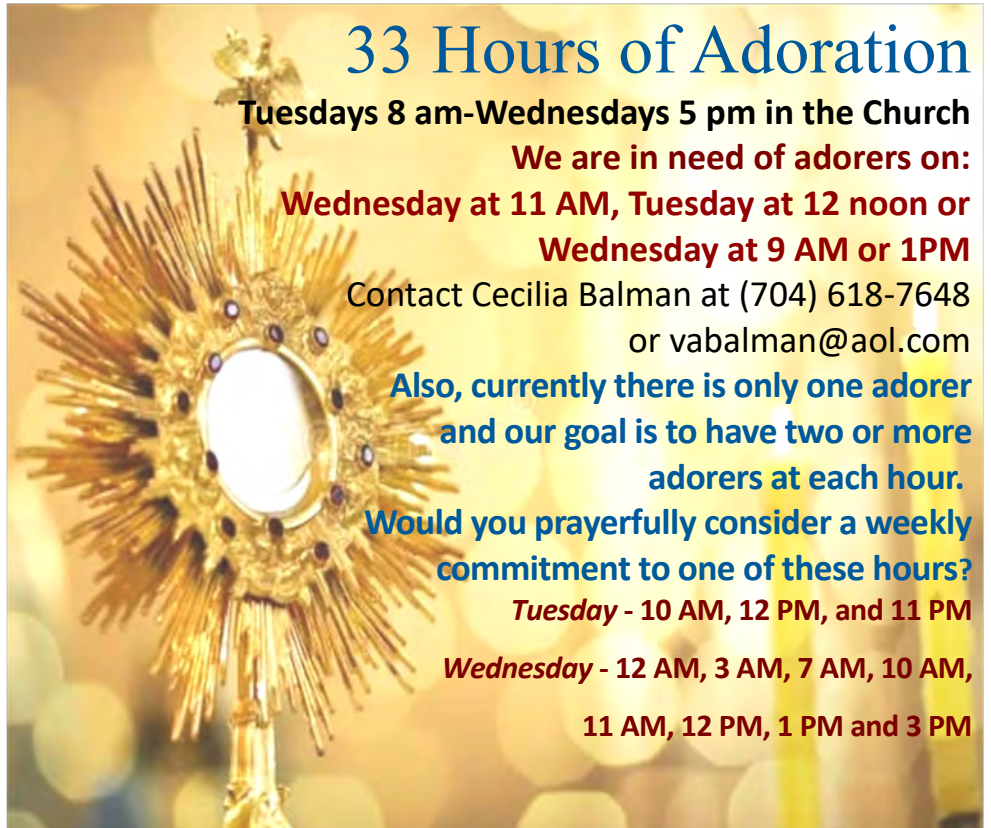

## Pilgrimage to the National Shrine of St. Dymphna

You are invited to join Fr. Benjamin Roberts, pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes, Monroe, NC, on a 3-day pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Saint Dymphna located in Massillon, Ohio. The dates are March 16 - 18, 2025. The itinerary includes Holy Mass both days, a tour of the National Shrine of St. Dymphna and the Basilica of St. Mary of the Assumption. We will spend time in prayer in front of the relics of all twelve apostles, St. Dymphna, and a relic of the True Cross. The cost is \$199.00 per person which includes all meals and roundtrip transportation aboard a luxury motor coach.
