## Dear Parishioners,



Happy **Laetare Sunday**. “Laetare” is a Latin word which means “rejoice”, and we are rejoicing because we are now at the midpoint in our Lenten journey. In just three weeks we will be celebrating the glories of Easter. Today the Church encourages us to

have a foretaste of that Easter glory. Like a ray of light breaking through dark clouds, we are given a brief respite from the rigors of our fasting and penances so that we can focus ourselves more clearly on the joy that is to come. Thus, the violet representing our penance is set aside for the day in lieu of a more festive rose color that symbolizes the lightening of our penance, and we are called to rejoice because we will soon see the redemption that Christ will procure for us at Easter!

I am grateful to all of you who’ve already completed the **Disciple Maker Index**. The information that we’re collecting will both help the diocese in their pastoral planning and provide meaningful data for our parish as we continue planning for the future. Hopefully, everyone is keeping up with their Lenten

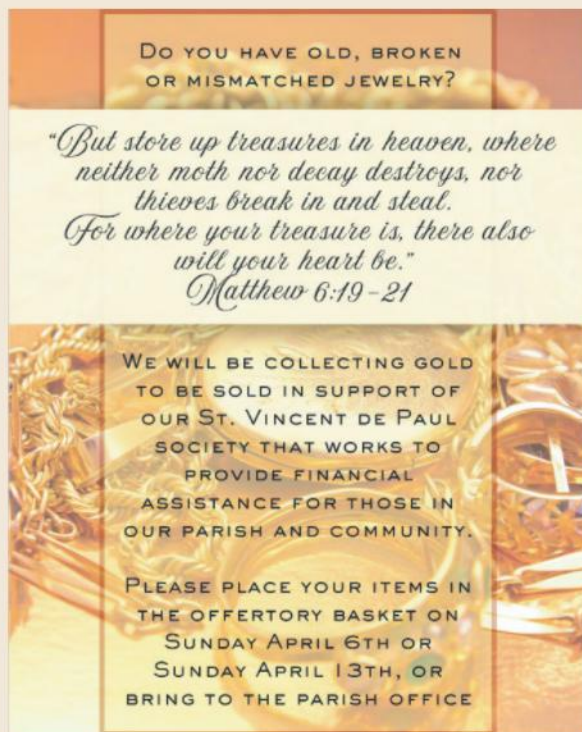

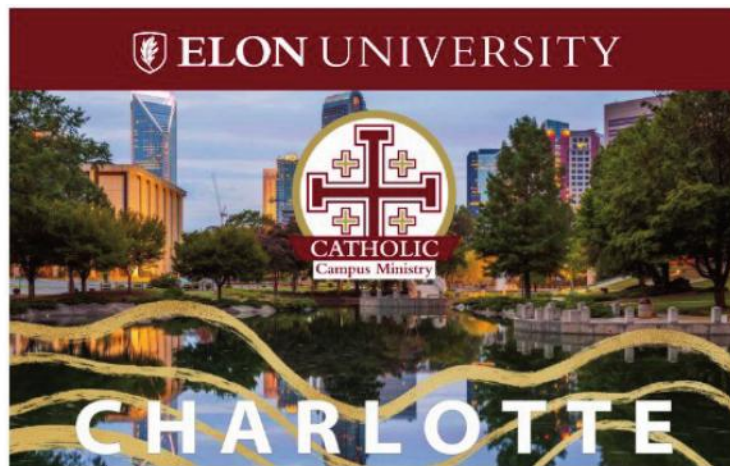
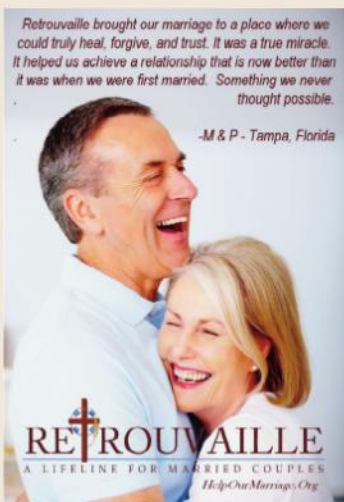

## Holy Saturday Blessing of Easter Food Baskets--St. Thomas Aquinas Church

On **Holy Saturday**, April 19th at 1:00 p.m., Deacon James Witulski will be blessing Easter Food Baskets at St. Thomas Aquinas Church. **The Blessing, in both the English and Polish languages, will take place in the Church.**

This Eastern & Central European tradition is called **The Blessing of the Easter Baskets**, or, **Swieconka**, in the Polish language, and will last about 30 minutes. This tradition has become popular among many Catholics.

The traditional foods, such as sausages, eggs, bread, and butter in the shape of a lamb, are brought to the Church, neatly arranged in a basket. However, **every person of any nationality is invited** to use their imagination and include their own national foods.
