Sunday. "Laetare" is a Latin word which means "rejoice", and we are rejoicing because we are now at the midpoint in our Lenten journey. In just three weeks we will be celebrating the glories of Easter.

Like a ray of light breaking through dark clouds, we are given a brief respite from the rigors of our fasting and penances so that we can focus ourselves more clearly on the joy that is to come. 

Hopefully, everyone is keeping up with their Lenten






This Eastern & Central European tradition is called





