St. Ann Parish seeks the salvation of souls through the redemption of Jesus Christ as revealed to us in and through the divinely instituted Holy Catholic Church.

We invite all to receive God's love as we give of ourselves in compassionate service.

Dear Parishioners,



With today's Palm Sunday liturgy we enter into that most important week of the year for us Catholics, that week which we call holy. And we call this week holy because God, in His infinite goodness, takes what should be considered the most horrific and unjust of

crimes: the wrongful indictment and execution of His own Son, and makes of it the means for our salvation. In our liturgies this week we will see the conspiracy that brought about Jesus' wrongful arrest. We will sit with Christ at the Last Supper as He gives us the inseparable gifts of the priesthood and the Eucharist, and we will follow Him into the Garden of Gethsemane to watch with Him. We will witness all that He suffers for us, and we will stand at the foot of the cross with His Mother as Jesus dies for our sins. And finally we will peer into the empty tomb on the third day and experience anew the glory of His resurrection. What a holy week indeed!

As your pastor I personally invite all of you to come and participate in the liturgies. Meditate on all the great mysteries of our salvation. Enter into the mysteries of our faith, for this week is different than any other week of the year. And be sure to pray for our fellow parishioners who will be entering into full communion with the Church through the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter

Vigil on Holy Saturday night.

Our **Holy Thursday Mass** will be at 7 p.m., and we will have Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until Midnight. On **Good Friday** we will have Stations of the Cross at noon, and confessions from noon – 2pm. The Passion Liturgy of Good Friday will be at 3 p.m., and our **Easter Vigil** on Holy Saturday will begin at 8:30 p.m. Bear in mind that this is a long Mass – often around 3 hours – so plan accordingly. Our Masses on Easter Sunday will be as normal: 8am, 10:30am, and 12:30pm (Latin).

As a reminder, in preparation for Divine Mercy Sunday, which is always the Sunday immediately following Easter, it is customary for Catholics to pray the Divine Mercy Novena daily, beginning on Good Friday and ending on Divine Mercy Sunday. Additionally, Catholics who receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday, go to confession within 20 days of Divine Mercy Sunday, and who pray for the intentions of the pope (a *Creed* and an *Our Father* will suffice) are granted a plenary indulgence. We generally have copies of this novena in the North Vestibule. This is a very spiritually beneficial devotion that I hope many of you will participate in.






This Eastern & Central European tradition is called


The Blessing of the Easter Baskets, or, **Swieconka**, in the Polish language, and will last about 30 minutes. This tradition has become popular among many Catholics.


