

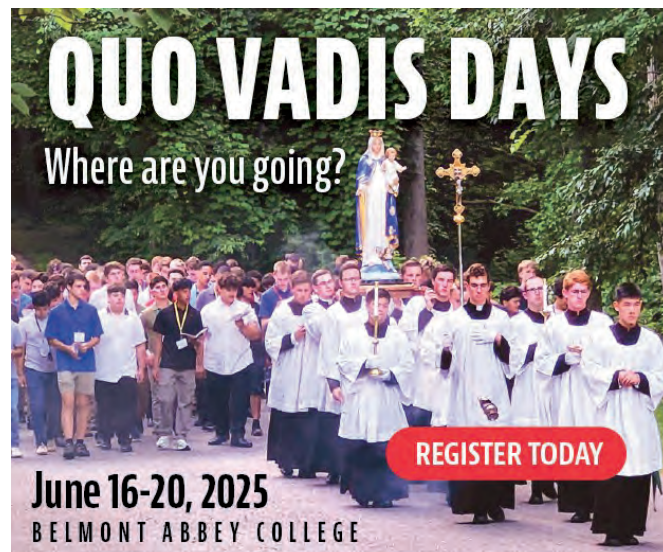

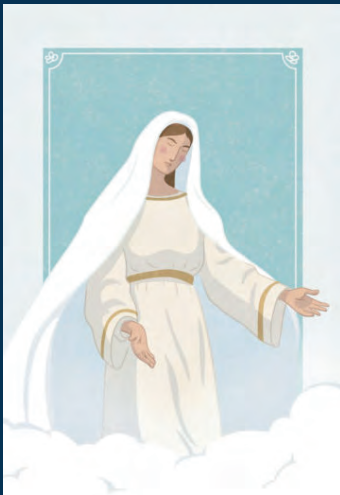

St. Joan of Arc is honored for her role in the siege of Orléans and her insistence on the coronation of Charles VII of France during the Hundred Years' War. Claiming to be acting under divine guidance, she became a military leader who transcended gender roles and gained recognition as a savior of France. Captured and tried for heresy, she was ultimately martyred in 1431, but her legacy endures as a symbol of courage and faith.

- Born: c.1412, Domrémy, France
- Died: May 30, 1432 (age 19), Rouen, France
- Canonized: May 16, 1920 by Pope Benedict XV
- Feast Day: May 30

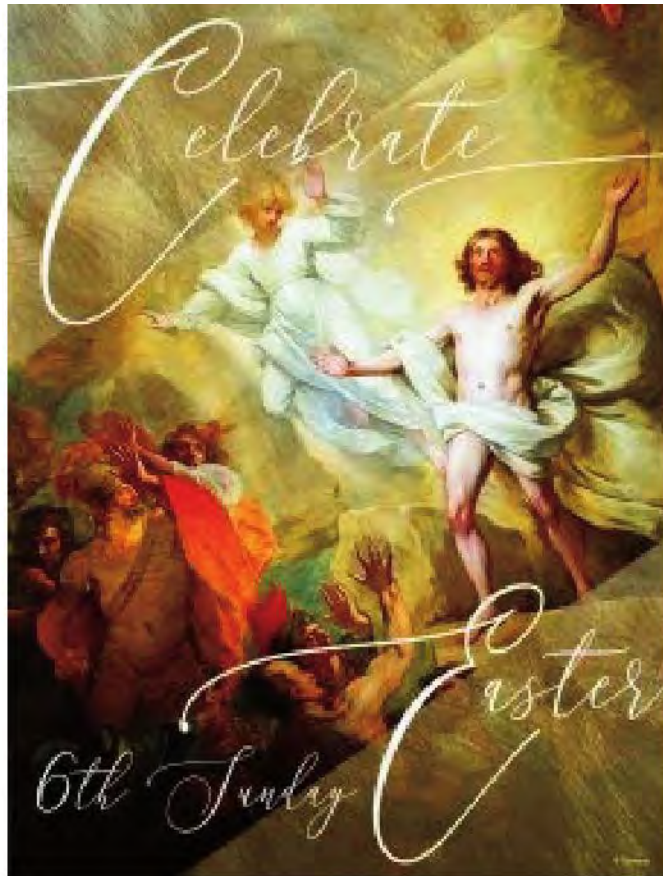
