

A blessed and happy Memorial Day weekend! As we pray at Mass this weekend, let's be sure to pray for the repose of the souls of our fallen soldiers who died in the service of our country.

This Thursday, 29 May 2025, we will

have our annual Latin Mass in honor of Our Lord's Ascension. This year we will use this occasion to bless our new stained-glass windows. These windows, dedicated to the honor of the 12 Apostles, were several years in the making, and I've been delighted to hear from so many of you of how happy you are with them. Please join us for what is always a very beautiful Mass.

Our annual Homeschool Graduation is this coming Saturday, 31 May 2025. The 4:30pm Mass that evening will serve as the Baccalaureate Mass, with the graduation ceremony to follow. Let's be sure to pray for all our graduating young people as they head on to the next stage of their lives.

Looking ahead to next month, please be sure to pray for our parishioners Peter Townsend and Robbie Bauman. They are being ordained as deacons on Saturday, 07 June 2025, at St. Mark's in Huntersville. Peter and Robbie have both just completed their 3 rd year of major seminary and have just one more year until priesthood. 

ST. JOAN OF ARC

St. Joan of Arc is honored for her role in the siege of Orléans and her insistence on the coronation of Charles VII of France during the Hundred Years' War. Claiming to be acting under divine guidance, she became a military leader who transcended gender roles and gained recognition as a savior of France. Captured and tried for heresy, she was ultimately martyred in 1431, but her legacy endures as a symbol of courage and faith.

 Canonized: May 16, 1920 by Pope Benedict XV






