Dear Parishioners,



There's much to look forward to in the coming days and weeks here at St.
Ann's. This coming Saturday, 07 June 2025, two of our parishioners: Peter Townsend and Robbie Bauman will be ordained as deacons! The ordination will take place at 9am at St.

Mark Catholic Church in Huntersville, and it is open to the public. Peter will be serving the 10:30am Mass next Sunday and will preach the homily. Robbie will serve at the 8am Mass and preach at the 12:30pm Mass next Sunday. Please pray that Peter, Robbie, and their classmates will be good and holy deacons in the coming year, and that they will persevere to the priesthood!

Bishop Martin will be visiting our parish to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday, 10 June 2025 at 6pm. This year we have 36 young people being confirmed. Please keep them in your prayers as they make this important step in their spiritual lives.

Our annual Corpus Christi celebration is June 19-22. We will begin with a Corpus Christi Latin Mass on Thursday, 19 June 2025 at 7pm. That will be followed by 40 Hours of Eucharistic Adoration, which will conclude on Saturday, 21 June at 4pm.

As always, we will have our annual Corpus Christi procession on Sunday, 22 June after the 10:30am Mass. Keep an eye out for information on how to sign up for an hour of adoration that weekend.

After last weekend's sad announcement of the cancelling of the Traditional Latin Mass in parish churches throughout our diocese, I hope many of you are finding peace through prayer. As I mentioned in my homily last Sunday, we must give no room to bitterness or despair, though we must feel justly angry. Indeed, sufferings like this have the power to transform us when we embrace them with faith in God's goodness. On this topic, keep in mind that Bishop Martin will hold a meeting at the new Latin Mass chapel at 757 Oakridge Farm Hwy in Mooresville, NC, on Tuesday, 24 June 2025 at 6pm, for those who would like to visit there and learn more about this transition with the Latin Mass in the Diocese of Charlotte.

Just as a reminder, I do ask any of you writing to the bishop's office about the Latin Mass to be respectful, charitable, and to refrain from making judgments about his motives. Angry rants do nothing to help this cause. To the contrary, the saints show us that humility, charity, and steadfast prayer and penance win the day.
