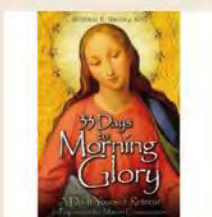

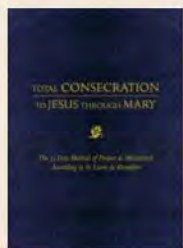
Dear Parishioners,

I am so very grateful to all of you who have been part of our **40 Hours of Adoration** this weekend as we celebrate the great feast of Corpus Christi! Time spent in front of the Blessed Sacrament is holy time, and it has a marvelously salutary effect on our souls. I very much believe that when we die and stand before God in judgment, we will see how efficacious our hours of Adoration were in helping us become holy.



It's time to begin preparing for our annual **Marian Consecration**, which begins on July 13th. You can use either Fr. Michael Gaitley's book: *33 Days to Morning Glory*, or St. Louis de Montfort's *True Devotion to Mary* (just be sure to get a version with the consecration preparation included in the book).

Then, following each of the Masses on August 15th, which is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (and the anniversary of our parish founding), those who have prepared will make the consecration to Mary. *If you have made the consecration in the past, I encourage you to renew it every year.*



Countless saints throughout our Church's history have encouraged the faithful to turn to Mary in their every need, and solemnly consecrating oneself to her is "the surest, easiest, shortest, and the most perfect means" to becoming a saint (St. Louis de Montfort).
