# Dear Parishioners,



Just as a reminder, you are most welcome to visit our newly renovated school this Sunday after the 8am and 10:30am Masses. More than \$5 million has been poured into the school over the past 3 months, most of it coming from the Shea Family Foundation, who gave us a \$3.5 million grant. Without their

generosity this project would never have been possible. I'm also very grateful to our parishioners and school parents who've contributed so generously to the project.

I've started planning our next parish pilgrimage, which will take place September 21 – October 2, 2026. We will be heading to Poland and Lithuania. Tour highlights will include sites associated with St. Faustina and Divine Mercy, Pope St. John Paul II, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and St. Edith Stein, and we will also visit the famous Black Madonna of Our Lady of Czestochowa. For those of you who went with me to Poland in 2014, this pilgrimage will include some of the same sites, but we'll be going to a whole host of other sites we didn't see on that trip.
