As the new school year gets underway, I hope many of you have already registered your children for **Faith Formation**, which will begin next Sunday. Please check the parish website for the Faith Formation schedule. Any questions you have can be directed to either Virginia Blatchford, our Faith Formation Director, or

her assistant, Mary Bruck, at the Faith Formation office: 704-523-4641, ext. 231.

As we prepare to start up Faith Formation classes in a couple of weeks, it's also time to prepare for **OCIA** (The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults – formerly “RCIA”). This is our class for those who are interested in converting to Catholicism. If you or anyone you know is interested in learning more about our Catholic Faith, our first OCIA class will be Monday, 08 September 2025 at 7pm. We meet in Classrooms 1&2 of the Activity Center.

And please don't forget the annual **Eucharistic Congress**, which will take place this coming Friday and Saturday (September 5-6, 2025) at the Charlotte Convention Center. The Congress is getting revamped this year, and it will begin on Friday evening with a concert featuring Christian artist Matt Maher. This will be followed by an exclusive screening of *Carlo Acutis: Roadmap to Reality*, a documentary movie about one of the newest saints of the Church.

The Congress will continue on Saturday with a

Eucharistic procession, holy hour, and talks from nationally-known Catholic speakers. The Congress will conclude Saturday evening with a Mass offered by our bishop. There are also programs for families with children, tracks for high school and college students, as well as tracks for Hispanic and Vietnamese Catholics.

Please keep in mind that *there will be no Saturday confessions or anticipated Mass on September 6th*, per our bishop's request, so that all priests can attend the closing Mass of the Congress. Our Masses on Sunday will be as usual.

Lastly, our next **parish pilgrimage** will be September 21 – October 2, 2026. We will be heading to Poland and Lithuania. Tour highlights will include sites associated with St. Faustina and Divine Mercy, Pope St. John Paul II, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and St. Edith Stein, and we will also visit the famous Black Madonna of Our Lady of Czestochowa. For those of you who went with me to Poland in 2014, this pilgrimage will include some of the same sites, but we'll be going to a whole host of other sites we didn't see on that trip.

Registration for the pilgrimage is now open on the Tekton Ministries website. 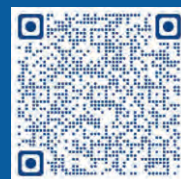
