Dear Parishioners,



This coming Wednesday, 01 October 2025, will we offer our last Latin Mass at St. Ann's. Per our normal Wednesday schedule, the Mass will be at 6pm. Rather than a low Mass, this will be a solemn high Mass, and it will be a votive Mass in honor of St. Ann. Please join us for this historic Mass.

As I mentioned in last Sunday's bulletin, starting next Sunday our 12:30pm Mass will be Novus Ordo, like our other Sunday Masses. Yet, for this Mass we will be using the music we've been accustomed to at the Latin Mass. Our hope is to preserve the contemplative atmosphere of the Latin Mass that so many of us find alluring.

For those of you planning to make the Latin Mass chapel in Mooresville your new liturgical home, please remember that St. Ann's is still your parish home, and that the Latin Mass chapel will act as a sort of extension to our parish. Outside of Sunday Mass at the chapel, your sacraments, faith formation, and pastoral care will remain at St. Ann's. Also, as there will be no collection taken at the Mooresville chapel and no ministries exercised there, you are asked to continue giving of your time, talent, and treasure through St. Ann's. Keeping the chapel in Mooresville open will likely cost our parish a significant amount of money in years to come, and so your continued generosity to St. Ann's is necessary and appreciated.

But if I may say so, I do hope that those of you who attend Latin Mass regularly in Mooresville will

occasionally come to Sunday Mass here at St. Ann's. The deacons and I are going to miss seeing you here every Sunday!

No Longer a Tool: The Realities of Technology on Household and Community



"The opposite of life is not death; it is the machine." – Dr. Ian McGilchrist

There was a time when technological advancements were bedazzling, and the new efficiencies were making life easier and more enjoyable. But, we can no longer pretend this is a matter of tools we use. Increasingly we have become the tool used by and for powers that are not only against our best interest and health, but against nature and even God.

Parents can no longer be passive, nor can they take a victim mentality that gives up all authority to media and tech. A couple decades of smartphones and social media has given us the data to know we cannot claim ignorance at the harm being inflicted in the walls of our own homes. But parents also cannot do this alone and Catholic communities must take more seriously their support for one another in this regard.

In this talk, local author and co-founder of Fraternus Jason M. Craig will move quickly past the calls for content censoring and monitoring and speak more about how technology is changing the way we think, pray, and relate to one another, with proposals for a communal answer to this engulfing question.
