Dear Parishioners,



Happy and blessed **Feast of Christ the King!** As we prepare to enter the holy season of Advent next Sunday, it's good for us to renew our love for our blessed Savior, Who is our almighty King. As the kingship of Christ is so often attacked and maligned in the public square, it's good for us

to renew our assent to what we believe about Jesus Christ as Catholics.

In short, we believe that in Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Son of God, the full revelation of Truth is given. Fully God and fully man, Jesus is the only Savior of mankind; He alone can save us from sin, death, the power of the evil one, and eternal damnation. Jesus alone can reconcile us to the Father, and thus there is no salvation in any other name (cf. Acts 4:22). Truly, Jesus Christ is the way, the truth, and the life, and no one goes to the Father except through Him (cf. Jn 4:6).

We also believe that Jesus Christ instituted the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church: a hierarchical Church founded upon Peter and the Apostles, which is governed by the Pope (as Peter's successor) and the Bishops (as successors to the Apostles). Along with governing the Church, the Pope and the Bishops united to him have the authority to teach and sanctify the members of the Church. Yet, the teaching authority of the Pope and Bishops is not an authority to create or invent doctrine contrary to the teachings of Christ revealed in Scripture and Tradition. Moreover, Jesus continues His Presence and work of salvation in the Church, and therefore Christ's one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church alone is the means to salvation.

As we honor Christ as King, I hope that all of you will renew your steadfast love for our beloved Savior and be willing to defend His honor when He and His Church are attacked and maligned. Pray, too, for our Church leadership, especially our holy father, Pope Leo, and all bishops, that they may truly have the mind of Christ when making decisions for the Church.

The Mass on **Thanksgiving Day** will be at 9am, and there will be no confessions that evening. There will be no Masses on Friday, 28 November 2025. Also, the church office will be closed Wednesday – Friday. As we head into this national holiday, let us be sure to offer our Lord proper thanks for His many gifts to our parish family.

In recent years, the Tuesday after Thanksgiving has become "**Giving Tuesday**" – a day to give to charity to counterbalance the materialistic excesses of "Black Friday" and "Cyber-Monday." If you're disposed to make a special gift next Tuesday, our parish can certainly use it. In particular, we are a little behind on what we owe for the Diocesan Support Appeal and the Priests' Retirement assessment.

I am ever grateful for the generous culture of stewardship we have at St. Ann's. We're a growing parish with a lot of needs (and some debt!), and being good stewards of our time, talent, and treasure is a way for us to love, honor, and thank our God and King for His many blessings. May our generosity be for each of us a way to step out in faith, trusting that God will always provide for our needs when we are generous with Him first.

These words were not written today, but come to us from our beloved St John Paul the great in 1981, in his Apostolic Exhortation *Familiaris Consortio*. They are obviously even more true today than they were then. With our passionate conviction that marriage and family is, as he says, "one of the most precious of human values", we at this parish seek to support and accompany families to a greater degree than they might normally find. All of our ministries are directed at helping form, encourage and support our families' growth in holiness at every age and stage. One new way we have been doing this for the past year, is hosting an NFP support group here at the parish, for seasons in marriage where more support is needed - whether that be emotionally, physically or spiritually.

Launched last year as a highly successful pilot in three Catholic parishes across the country, this program offers engaged and married couples a space to learn about and support one another in NFP, fertility, and relationships.

Are you in a season where you have serious reasons for avoiding pregnancy, but NFP still feels burdensome and hard? This is what our NFP support group is for. One hour, once a month, for both spouses, led by trained couples - and with free childcare!
