Dear Parishioners,



A blessed Thanksgiving weekend to you! Please know how thankful I am for our parish family and the many graces our Lord has bestowed upon us. I'm especially grateful for your love, patience, generosity, and your prayers for Fr. Jones and me. We're especially relying upon your prayers as we contend with the challenges this year

has presented.

As we give thanks this weekend, I want you to be aware of the many blessings our parish gives to others. In addition to the monies we raise for our St. Vincent de Paul Society and Homeless Ministry, and the money that we collect in poor boxes, we also set aside a portion of each Sunday's collection to provide funds to local ministries and organizations that perform corporal works of mercy (feeding the poor, housing the homeless, etc.); to support pro-life efforts; and to take care of individuals and families whose assistance needs are greater than what our St. Vincent de Paul Society can handle. We also support agencies that aid victims of sex trafficking, as well as MiraVia and ANSWER, a local non-profit that provides scholarships to single working moms so they can get an education and a better job. And, of course, we give generously to the Missionaries of the Poor. Without your generosity every Sunday with our weekly collection, we couldn't do this – so thank you!

In recent years, the Tuesday after Thanksgiving has become “**Giving Tuesday**” – a day to give to charity to counterbalance the materialistic excesses of “Black Friday” and “Cyber-Monday.” If you're disposed to make a special gift on Tuesday, our parish can certainly use it. In particular, we are a

little behind on what we owe for the Diocesan Support Appeal and the Priests' Retirement assessment. Thanks again for your generosity.

As we've done in years past, I invite all of you to join me in a **special novena to Our Lady** from November 30 – December 8. As we've done for many years, I will re-consecrate our parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception at the 6 p.m. Mass on Monday, December 8. In preparation for this, I ask you to consider fasting from something you enjoy (as you would during Lent) and praying the following Novena Prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary each day from November 30–December 8:

O Most Blessed Mother, heart of love, heart of mercy, ever listening, caring, consoling, hear our prayer. As your children, we implore your intercession with Jesus your Son. Receive with understanding and compassion the petitions we place before you today, especially that our parish may be consecrated to your Immaculate Heart and each member may grow in true holiness. We are comforted in knowing your heart is ever open to those who ask for your prayer. We trust to your gentle care and intercession those whom we love and who are sick or lonely or hurting. Help all of us, Holy Mother, to bear our burdens in this life until we may share eternal life and peace with God forever, and keep and guard St. Ann's Parish as your own property and possession. Amen.

Keep in mind that the Feast of the Immaculate Conception is a holy day of obligation. We will have Mass that day at 7a.m., 12 noon, and 6p.m.

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **Online registration takes place at the St. Ann parish website.** Our classes run each Sunday. **Our next Sundays off are November 23 & 30th for Thanksgiving break.** Contact Virginia Blatchford with questions at faithformation@stanncharlotte.org

1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet. The homework packet is due at the **First Confession Retreat on January 31st** from 9-12noon in the Allen Center.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet**. The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey**. Note our confirmation students interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm**. Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 1230 Mass**. Rehearsal is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm**. **Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time. **Teen Apologetics-** We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend. **Our next Sundays off are November 23 & 30th for Thanksgiving break.**

Prayerfully consider if you are being called to be a **sponsor for a man, woman, or child that is coming into the Church at the Easter Vigil or being confirmed after a time away from the Catholic Church on Divine Mercy Sunday**. This ministry asks you to get to know the person you will sponsor. You can meet with them, share a coffee, and make a phone call to talk or answer questions. You will pray for them as they attend Monday evening classes, and be present on the day they receive their sacraments. These words were not written today, but come to us from our beloved St John Paul the great in 1981, in his Apostolic Exhortation *Familiaris Consortio*. They are obviously even more true today than they were then. With our passionate conviction that marriage and family is, as he says, "one of the most precious of human values", we at this parish seek to support and accompany families to a greater degree than they might normally find. All of our ministries are directed at helping form, encourage and support our families' growth in holiness at every age and stage. One new way we have been doing this for the past year, is hosting an NFP support group here at the parish, for seasons in marriage where more support is needed - whether that be emotionally, physically or spiritually.

Launched last year as a highly successful pilot in three Catholic parishes across the country, this program offers engaged and married couples a space to learn about and support one another in NFP, fertility, and relationships.

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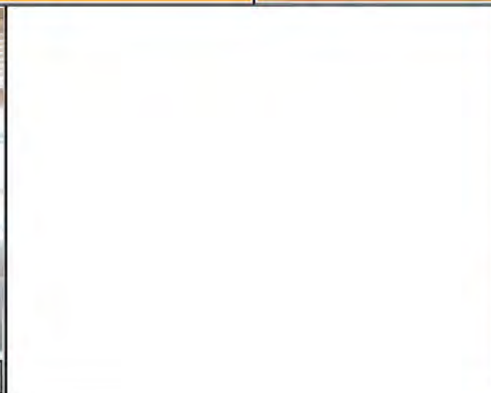
