December 14, 2025 • Third Sunday of Advent

Dear Parishioners,



“Rejoice in the Lord always! Again I say, rejoice! Indeed, the Lord is near.” These are the words of the entrance antiphon for today’s Mass on this Third Sunday of Advent (also known as *Gaudete Sunday*), and they signal for us the tone of today’s liturgy. While the violet we wear on most days of Advent indicate that there’s penitential nature

to this season, now that we are roughly halfway through Advent, we take a break from our penance and rejoice in joyful anticipation of our Lord’s coming, much like *Laetare Sunday* in Lent. The liturgy today reminds us that soon the great feast of Christmas will be upon us, and this is cause for rejoicing indeed. Symbolizing a lightening of our penance and our joyful anticipation for Christ’s coming, our liturgical color switches from violet to rose today. Our readings, too, take on a more joyful nature.

Wednesday, 17 December, our liturgies will begin to take on an even more eager and anticipatory nature as we move into a period of special preparation during Advent known as the Octave before Christmas. During this time special antiphons (known as the “O” antiphons) are used at vespers and for the *Alleluia* verse before the Gospel at Mass. These antiphons have been around since at least the 8th century, and each antiphon recalls a particular scriptural title of Jesus, announcing his imminent arrival and recalling the Old Testament prophecies of Isaiah. Moreover, they tell us something about the person of Christ and about salvation history. The famous Advent song *O Come, O Come, Emmanuel* that is often used this time of year is based upon these antiphons.

Christmas will soon be upon us. While I know many of us are busy with the social obligations, shopping, and domestic chores this season brings, let’s not forget to make time for our Lord in prayer. Preparing our hearts for His arrival at Christmas is the most important part of Advent. Come to Adoration and to daily Mass if you can.

One great way to prepare for Christmas is by attending our special Advent Mass in honor of Our Lady on Saturday, 20 December at 6:30 a.m. As with our Rorate Masses in the past, this Novus Ordo Mass will be celebrated using only candlelight, a reminder that the world was in darkness before the coming of the True Light of the World, Jesus Christ. I’ll think you’ll find it a Mass that is so wonderfully suited to the Advent theme of hopeful expectation of the coming of the Christ Child. Please come and join us as we anticipate the dawning of the Son of God at Christmas.

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **Our Christmas break will run from December 21st to January 1st. Our first class back will be on January 4th.** Contact Virginia Blatchford with questions at faithformation@stanncharlotte.org

1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet. The homework packet is due at the **First Confession Retreat on January 31st** from 9-12noon in the Allen Center.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet**. The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey**. Note our confirmation students will interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm**.

Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 1230 Mass**. **Rehearsal** is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm**. **Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time.

Teen Apologetics- We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend. **Our Christmas break will run from December 21st to January 1st. Our first class back will be on January 4th**

They also have programs on Saint Carlos and Saint Giorgio, and they have excellent ebooks for teens, audio books, saint shows, and formation materials like prayer songs and audio books.
