Dear Parishioners,



As we prepare to celebrate the Birth of Christ here at St. Ann's, I want to thank each of you for the many ways you share your gifts of time, talent, and treasure with our parish family. Your participation in the many good works of our parish community demonstrates that the light and love of the Christ Child shines brightly

here at St. Ann's! I am particularly grateful to our dedicated staff and volunteers who give generously of their time and talent to make St. Ann's the beautiful and big-hearted parish that it is.

Recognizing that this is the season of gift-giving, I ask you to prayerfully consider putting our parish on your year-end Christmas giving list. As we strive to meet the spiritual and pastoral needs of our parish family, we must also recognize the practical and financial needs of maintaining our growing parish on a day-to-day basis. While our weekly collections are meeting our budgetary needs, we've yet to meet our assessments for the DSA and the Priests' Retirement Collection this year. As you know, any shortfall on these assessments must be taken out of our parish coffers, limiting our ability to meet other parish needs.

In the past several years, we've been able to take care of several pressing maintenance needs in the church, the Allen Center, and around the parish property. Following the desires expressed in our parish survey last year, we've expanded our staffing this year and offered more adult formation opportunities. But there is still much more to do! Our next major projects will include a rectory renovation and expansion, resurfacing of the nave floor in the church, and adding a fountain to the

plaza between the church and Allen Center. If you'd like to donate to these projects, you can do so by contributing to the 5-Year plan (either by envelope or on our website). The good news is that we are on track to retire the rectory debt by May 2027! Thank you for your generosity to our parish's capital needs.

Looking ahead to Christmas, be aware that we will be cancelling Adoration on December 24-25. Our Christmas Mass schedule will be the usual: 4:30pm and 6:30pm on Christmas Eve; Midnight Mass and 9am Mass on Christmas Day. There will be no confessions on Thursday, December 25. Mass on Friday, December 26, will be at 9am (no 7am or 8:30am Masses).

Masses for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God will be 6pm on December 31; and 9am and 12 noon on January 1. We will have confessions on January 1 from 10am – 11:30am. We will also have Adoration December 30-31 as usual.

1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet. The homework packet is due at the **First Confession Retreat on January 31st** from 9-12noon in the Allen Center.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet**. The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey**. Note our confirmation students will interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm**. Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 1230 Mass**. Rehearsal is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm**. **Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time.

Teen Apologetics- We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend. **Our Christmas break will run from December 21st to January 1st. Our first class back will be on January 4th**

These words were not written today, but come to us from our beloved St John Paul the great in 1981, in his Apostolic Exhortation *Familiaris Consortio*. They are obviously even more true today than they were then. With our passionate conviction that marriage and family is, as he says, "one of the most precious of human values", we at this parish seek to support and accompany families to a greater degree than they might normally find. All of our ministries are directed at helping form, encourage and support our families' growth in holiness at every age and stage. One new way we have been doing this for the past year, is hosting an NFP support group here at the parish, for seasons in marriage where more support is needed - whether that be emotionally, physically or spiritually.

Launched last year as a highly successful pilot in three Catholic parishes across the country, this program offers engaged and married couples a space to learn about and support one another in NFP, fertility, and relationships.

Are you in a season where you have serious reasons for avoiding pregnancy, but NFP still feels burdensome and hard? This is what our NFP support group is for. One hour, once a month, for both spouses, led by trained couples - and with free childcare!
