Dear Parishioners,



As of Friday, 16 January 2026, we are no longer using the **altar rails** for the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass, per the directives given to us by Bishop Martin in his pastoral letter dated 17 December 2025. I'm very sorry that this is the case. But as I mentioned last Sunday, now that recourse has been made to rectify this situation, we must pray fervently and wait for God to act. As there is no clear consensus on whether the bishop has the right to make the decisions he's making, we're going to wait for the competent ecclesiastical authorities to render a decision. In the meantime, we're going to comply with Bishop Martin's directives re: our altar rail in humble respect and obedience. Again, it's very important to me that our parish remain above reproach as we navigate this situation. And I trust that you'll join me in offering up this cross in union with our Lord's own suffering. May our sacrifice in this regard be pleasing to God and help us all grow in greater holiness.

Please keep in mind that this Thursday, 22 January 2026, is the **anniversary of *Roe v. Wade***, the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion and has led to the deaths of 60 million American babies in the wombs of their mothers. While *Roe* has been

overturned, abortion has not gone away. So, let us pray in a particular way for the end to this shameful and horrendous practice that so offends our blessed Lord. Let us pray, too, for the healing of all those who have had an abortion, and anyone who has participated in an abortion in any way.

The **National Right to Life March** is this Friday, 23 January 2026, in Washington, D.C. I hope that some of you will attend. As we prepare to mark the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade* and prepare for the National Right to Life March, let us all take on a few extra penances to make reparation for the terrible sin of abortion.
