Dear Parishioners,



Many thanks to all of you who were able to attend the March for Life in Washington, DC this past Friday. It's always good to see so many of our parishioners at the North Carolina Pilgrims' Mass celebrated on the morning of the March.

Next Sunday a few of us from the parish will head off to the Philippines to visit the MOP mission in Manila. Please pray for us as we travel, and please know that I'm grateful to all of you who have generously given to our work with the MOP over the years. Our parish has donated hundreds of thousands of dollars to the MOP in India over the past decade, building new buildings and roads (including a chapel and several homes), repairing and renovating existing structures, paying for tuitions for dozens of kids, and paying for medicines, food, clothing, and all sorts of other necessities. I cannot tell you how proud I am of all that we've accomplished. As we've done so much good work in India, I think it's time for us to see if we can help out another MOP mission in need. Thank you for being so generous to the poor.

Next Monday is a special day in the liturgical life of the Church: **Candlemas**,

which is a feast day also known as the Presentation of the Lord. This is one of the oldest feasts in the liturgical calendar, and we know its roots stretch back at least to the early 4th century. With this feast we come to the end of the Christmas Cycle in the liturgy. This feast is called Candlemas because on this feast day the candles used at Mass for the upcoming year traditionally are blessed. It's also appropriate to bless candles for your personal use at home on this day, so please feel free to bring any candles you wish to have blessed for your home. We will be blessing candles at the beginning of the 7am Mass that day.

Dr. Paul A. Byrne is a Board-Certified Neonatologist and Pediatrician and is the founder of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Medical Center in St. Louis, MO, one of the first NICU's in the Midwest. He has been the Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Saint Louis University, Creighton University and the University of Toledo College of Medicine.

He is a member of the American Academy of Pediatrics and past-President of the Catholic Medical Association. Dr. Byrne has written several books and articles on brain death and life issues. Most recently he assisted in the famous case of Jahi McMath, a 13-year-old girl who was declared brain dead in 2013 but lived until her natural death in 2018. Dr. Byrne and his late wife Shirley are proud parents of 12 children, grandparents of 36 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
