Dear Parishioners,



This Sunday evening a few of us from the parish will head off to the Philippines to visit the **MOP mission in Manila**. Please pray for us as we travel, and please know that I'm grateful to all of you who have generously

given to our work with the MOP over the years. Our parish has donated hundreds of thousands of dollars to the MOP in India over the past decade, building new buildings and roads (including a chapel and several homes), repairing and renovating existing structures, paying for tuitions for dozens of kids, and paying for medicines, food, clothing, and all sorts of other necessities. I cannot tell you how proud I am of all that we've accomplished. As we've done so much good work in India, I think it's time for us to see if we can help out another MOP mission in need. Thank you for being so generous to the poor. We return on February 13.

This Monday is a special day in the liturgical life of the Church: **Candlemas**, which is a feast day also known as the Presentation of the Lord. This is one of the oldest feasts in the liturgical calendar, and we know its roots stretch back at least to the early 4th century. With this feast we come to the end of the Christmas

Cycle in the liturgy. This feast is called Candlemas because on this feast day the candles used at Mass for the upcoming year traditionally are blessed. It's also appropriate to bless candles for your personal use at home on this day, so please feel free to bring any candles you wish to have blessed for your home. We will be blessing candles at the beginning of the 7am Mass tomorrow.

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **The faith formation calendar is found on the parish website.** Contact Virginia Blatchford with questions at faithformation@stanncharlotte.org

1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet and hand it in as soon as possible. Our **First Confession Day for the class is on February 28th** at 10am in the church. **Plan to stay for the whole hour** to pray for the students going to confession. We will have adoration during the confession times.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet**. The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey**. Note our confirmation students will interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm**. Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 1230 Mass. Rehearsal** is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm. Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time.

Teen Apologetics- We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend.

Wells of Salvation for LENT: During this time of giving, I invite our families to participate in a special Lenten outreach — Cross Catholic's "Water for Life Africa" campaign. By joining this project, we will unite with other faithful parishes to help build wells, blessing nearly 600,000 men, women and children with safe, clean water. It is hard to believe that during a water-collection trip, an African woman will collect 20 to 60 liters of water. That's between five and 15 gallons. Unfortunately, what these women collect is rarely clean and safe. Please consider picking up a giving box at the Masses on February 21st and 22nd. Your donations will be due back by April 12th.

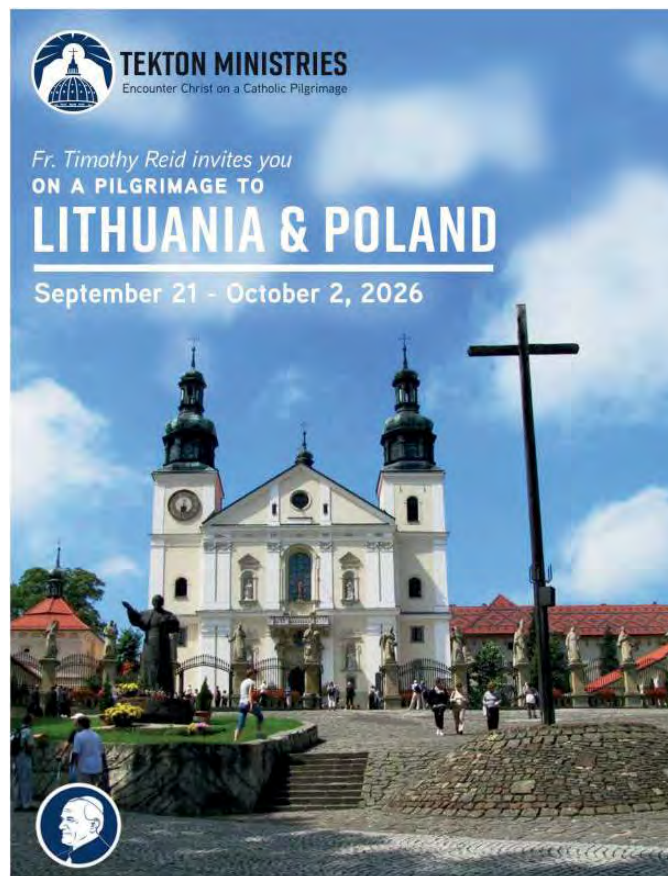

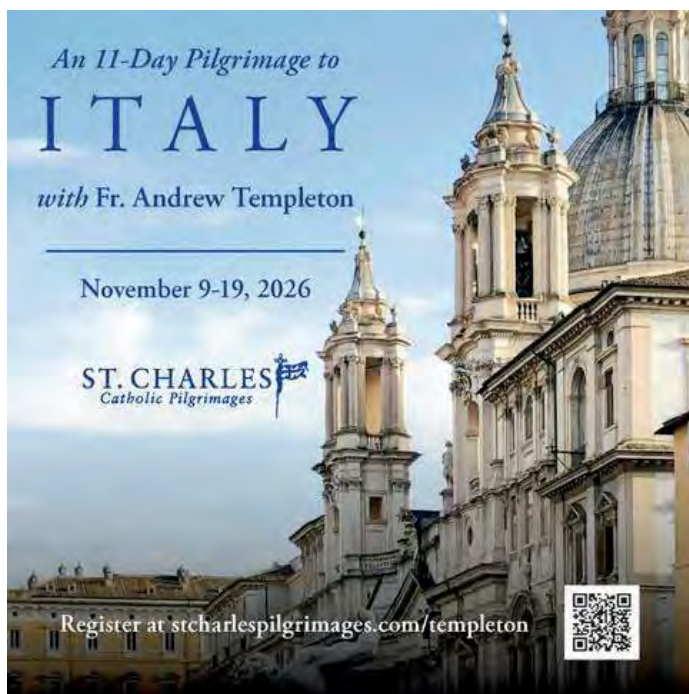

Dr. Paul A. Byrne is a Board-Certified Neonatologist and Pediatrician and is the founder of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Medical Center in St. Louis, MO, one of the first NICUs in the Midwest. He has been the Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Saint Louis University, Creighton University and the University of Toledo College of Medicine.

He is a member of the American Academy of Pediatrics and past-President of the Catholic Medical Association. Dr. Byrne has written several books and articles on brain death and life issues. Most recently he assisted in the famous case of Jahl McMath, a 13-year-old girl who was declared brain dead in 2013 but lived until her natural death in 2018. Dr. Byrne and his late wife Shirley are proud parents of 12 children, grandparents of 36 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

- Is brain death a valid criterion for organ donation?
- Are there financial conflicts of interest in declaring "brain death" for organ transplants?
- Are patients declared "brain dead" truly deceased?
- Why was the federal government investigating organ transplant organizations for ethical lapses?
- Should one be an organ donor or participate in organ transplants?


