Dear Parishioners,



Lent is almost here (it begins this Wednesday, 18 February 2026)! It's time to get down to the business of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving – all with the intention of loving God and neighbor better and becoming a little more like Christ! If you haven't yet chosen your Lenten sacrifices, it's time to do so. Just remember to choose

something that really pinches, something that is really a sacrifice for you – but not so much that your penance makes you a penance to those around you! More importantly, be sure to take on your Lenten penances with a desire to love God and to make of yourself an offering to Him. That will make your Lenten disciplines more efficacious for your soul and more pleasing to our Father in Heaven!

As Lent is a penitential season, Holy Mother Church has certain requirements for fasting and abstinence from meat during Lent. Specifically, for Catholics in the United States, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops states that: "the age of fasting is from the completion of the eighteenth year to the beginning of the sixtieth." The requirements for fasting and abstinence in the United States are:

- Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Every person from age of 18 until 59 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal a full meal.

Through observing the Church's laws re: fasting

and abstinence, I encourage you to make reparation for sin. Fasting and abstaining from meat shouldn't be empty rituals for us, but rather spiritual practices that we offer in reparation for all the ways our Lord has been offended. As we've done in the past, on most of the Fridays of Lent we will have a **Holy Hour of Reparation** at 6 p.m. in the church, followed by **Stations of the Cross** at 7 p.m. So please join us each Friday as we make reparation for our own sins and those of the whole Church.

Lastly, in addition to fasting and taking ascetical practices in Lent, it's good to do something positive. Practicing the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, almsgiving, attending daily Mass or making extra holy hours are all very positive things you can do to enrich your Lent. I certainly encourage you in this regard as well.

Just as a reminder, our Ash Wednesday Masses will be at 7am, 8:30am (school Mass), and 6pm. Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, but it's a great day to go to Mass – and a very good way to begin the holy season of Lent.

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **The faith formation calendar is found on the parish website.** Contact Virginia Blatchford with questions at faithformation@stanncharlotte.org
1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet and hand it in as soon as possible. Our **First Confession Day for the class is on February 28th** at 10am in the church. **Plan to stay for the whole hour** to pray for the students going to confession. We will have adoration during the confession times.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet.** The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey.** Note our confirmation students will interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm.** Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 12:30 Mass.** Rehearsal is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm.** **Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time.

Teen Apologetics: We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend.

Wells of Salvation for LENT: During this time of giving, I invite our families to participate in a special Lenten outreach — Cross Catholic's "Water for Life Africa" campaign. By joining this project, we will unite with other faithful parishes to help build wells, blessing nearly 600,000 men, women and children with safe, clean water. It is hard to believe that during a water-collection trip, an African woman will collect 20 to 60 liters of water. That's between five and 15 gallons. Unfortunately, what these women collect is rarely clean and safe. Please consider picking up a giving box at the Masses on February 21st and 22nd. Your donations will be due back by April 12th.




