Dear Parishioners,



Many thanks for all of your prayers while Deacon Peter, a few other parishioners, and I were on our mission trip to the Philippines. It was a beautiful trip! We worked with the Missionaries of the Poor in their Manila mission, which is just one of three sites they operate in the Philippines.

As we found the Manila mission to be well supported by locals, our parish is only going to fund a small project in the Manila mission to help the brothers collect rainwater. Instead, at the advice of the MOP regional superior, in the future we're going to visit and support the missions in Naga and Cebu, Philippines – which are more remote and do not have the same local support. It's my hope that we can do another mission trip to the Philippines in 2027.

St. Ann has been supporting the Missionaries of the Poor since the early 1990s. It all began with Msgr. Dick Allen, who began leading groups to the MOP mission in Kingston, Jamaica. When I arrived in 2007, I also led several mission trips to Jamaica. But as the Jamaica mission has lots of supporters, we pivoted to begin helping the missions in Kampala, Uganda, and Warangal, India. As you know, in the past decade our parish has done quite a bit to build up the Warangal mission.

same level of support to the missions in the Philippines that we did for the MOP mission in Warangal, India.

While we were in the Philippines, our mission group also spent some time with the Sisters of Mary at their schools in Cavite, Philippines: Girlstown and Boystown. The Sisters of Mary provide free housing, food, and education to deserving poor students grades 7-12 in several poorer nations around the world. I was so impressed by what I saw! The students were so happy and well-behaved, and they all graduate from the schools ready for jobs that will help break the cycle of poverty in their families. It was truly a joy to be in those schools and see the good work of the Sisters of Mary. Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **The faith formation calendar is found on the parish website.** Contact Virginia Blatchford with questions at faithformation@stanncharlotte.org
1st Communion Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the 1st Communion Packet and hand it in as soon as possible. Our **First Confession Day for the class is on February 28th** at 10am in the church. **Plan to stay for the whole hour** to pray for the students going to confession. We will have adoration during the confession times.

Confirmation Parents: Be sure to work weekly at home on the **Prior Knowledge Packet.** The signed pages are due at the confirmation retreat on **March 14th from 830am-300pm at Belmont Abbey.** Note our confirmation students will interview before they receive confirmation. Interviews will be on **March 23 from 4 to 7 pm.** Gather in the entry to the Allen Center and sign in as you arrive. Students will be interviewed by our Deacons, Priests, or teachers.

We also have our **Confirmation date of April 19th at the 12:30 Mass.** Rehearsal is the day before on **April 18th at 2pm.** **Sponsors and Candidates** will gather in the Church. Be prompt so we can start on time.

Teen Apologetics: We meet on each of the Faith Formation days from 9:00am-10:10am. We are using a Fulton Sheen source for our apologetics, and we meet upstairs in the Allen Center, classroom 1 and 2! Bring a friend.

Wells of Salvation for LENT: During this time of giving, I invite our families to participate in a special Lenten outreach — Cross Catholic’s “Water for Life Africa” campaign. By joining this project, we will unite with other faithful parishes to help build wells, blessing nearly 600,000 men, women and children with safe, clean water. It is hard to believe that during a water-collection trip, an African woman will collect 20 to 60 liters of water. That’s between five and 15 gallons. Unfortunately, what these women collect is rarely clean and safe. Please consider picking up a giving box at the Masses on February 21st and 22nd. Your donations will be due back by April 12th.




