important, but we do not do them for their own sake. We pray more, fast more, and give more in Lent all with the intent of becoming more like Christ and pleasing to God the Father.

Tour highlights will include sites associated with St. Faustina and Divine Mercy, Pope St. John Paul II, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and St. Edith Stein, and we will also visit the famous Black Madonna of Our Lady of Czestochowa. For those of you who went with me to Poland in 2014, this pilgrimage will include some of the same sites, but we'll be going to a whole host of other sites we didn't see on that trip.


