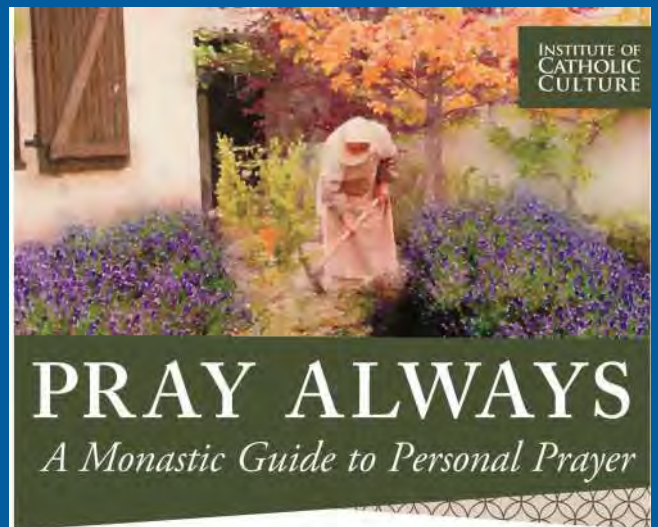

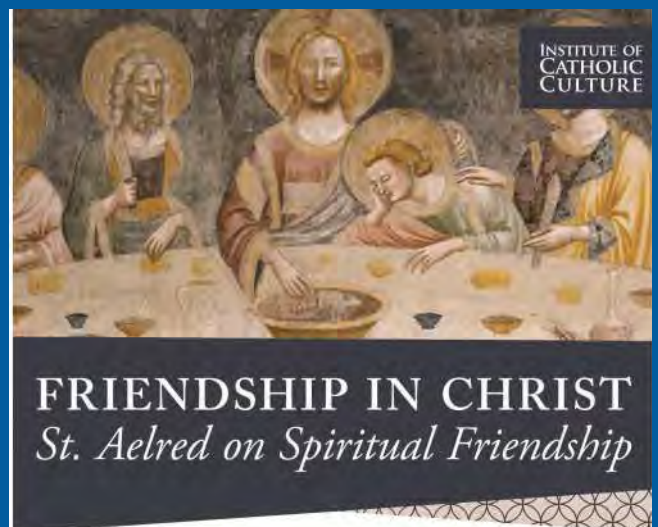

An accomplished pianist, she graduated from Rice University in music performance and won a seat as the youngest member of the Columbus Symphony Orchestra. She surprised many by leaving the orchestra to enter the monastery in 2003. It is now her greater delight to lead a choir of virgins, 85 strong, in the praises of the Lord across four houses in the US and UK.
