## Dear Parishioners,



A blessed Divine Mercy Sunday to you! This is always one of my favorite feasts of the year, for it reminds us so clearly of God's unfathomable love for us. As we consider all that our Lord promised St. Faustina about His divine mercy, we see

that there is nothing that should ever keep us from God. As long as we are sorry for our sins, repent of them, and confess them, then His mercy covers all things – even the worst of our sins. Who of us cannot take great comfort in that?

With this in mind, I encourage you to make good use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation from time to time. While Holy Mother Church only requires us to go to Confession once a year, it is a very good practice to go to confession regularly (say, every 4-6 weeks) – even for just venial sins. It is there in the confessional that God's mercy is poured upon us so generously and in such a way that not only are our sins forgiven, but we are given new strength to overcome our persistent sins. When we humbly approach our Lord in the confessional with true sorrow for our sins, He opens wide His arms and draws us so gently to Himself.

Speaking of God's mercy, this Sunday at the

12:30pm Mass we have the pleasure of welcoming into the Church the members of our OCIA program who have already been baptized. Because our OCIA program is so large this year, we simply couldn't provide the Sacraments of Initiation for everyone at the Easter Vigil as we've done in years past. What a wonderful problem to have! Please be sure to welcome our newest parishioners.

Lastly, we have a new memorial opportunity for our parish. It's my hope to create a brand-new rose window for the original church façade that faces Park Road. This is not a window that can be seen from inside our church, but it can be seen as you pass by our church on Park Road. Thus, our plan is to backlight it at night so that it can be seen by the folks passing by. Over the years, I've gotten lots of comments from people in the area about how grateful they are to see our statue of the Divine Mercy that faces Park Road lit up every night. This window will be a beautiful addition to the evangelical witness given by our church building. The cost of this project will be \$75,000. If you're interested in memorializing this window, please contact me directly.

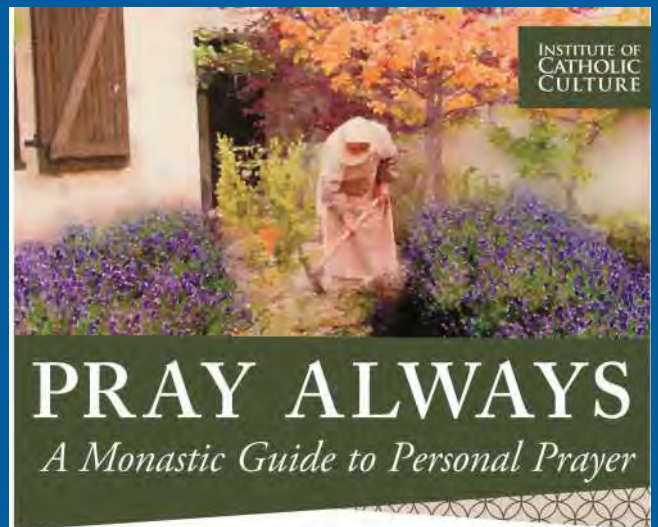

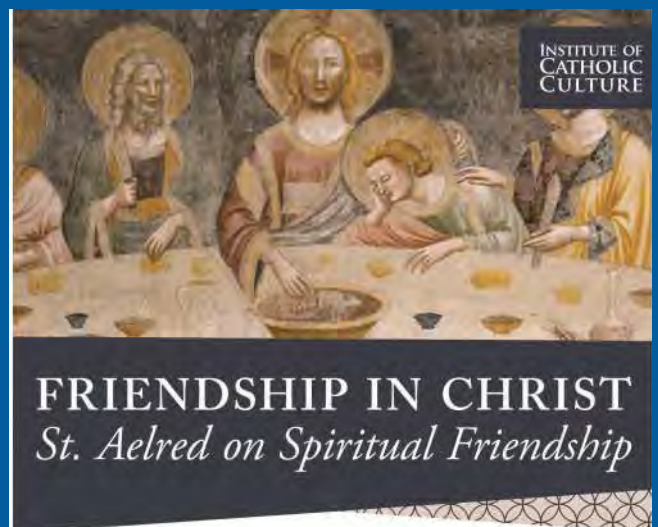

She surprised many by leaving the orchestra to enter the monastery in 2003. It is now her greater delight to lead a choir of virgins, 85 strong, in the praises of the Lord across four houses in the US and UK.
