Dear Parishioners,



Our little parish has been blessed with abundant growth in the past couple of years! Each Sunday the deacons and I meet new people at Mass, which is a blessing. As our parish grows, so too does the necessity for each of us to be patient with one another as our Masses grow more crowded. So, let me give you a few thoughts to help us all get the most out of Mass.

Firstly, please be patient with ushers as they are looking out for the safety and well-being of

all of us. They also help facilitate a reverent atmosphere for our Sunday Masses, and are thus the de facto enforcers of our parish rules for attending Mass. So, please be courteous to them at all times. For example, ushers are not supposed to let folks into the nave while the readings, responsorial psalm and Gospel are being read. This is to give respect to the profound dignity of the Word of God, as well as to mitigate distractions to our lectors and those listening to the readings.

With this in mind, please have children use the restrooms before Mass. If your children must exit the nave during the readings, understand that they will not be let back into the nave until the readings have concluded. And for their safety, it's best if children under the age of 12 are accompanied by an adult or older teen because there is no supervision in the restrooms.

I am grateful to those who take their children out of the nave when they are fussy or noisy. The acoustics in our church are excellent, which means that voices carry and occasionally Mass can get very loud. Bear in mind, as well, that any noise in the narthex carries right back into the church. I understand that our cry rooms often fill up (I really thought 2 cry rooms would be enough when we renovated the church!), so if your child is exceptionally noisy, you may need to step outside. We are currently looking into upgrading our outdoor speakers to improve your ability to participate in the Mass if you do have to go outside. Thank you for being sensitive to your fellow parishioners who are trying to participate in the Mass!

If your child is quiet enough to stay in the narthex without disrupting those in the nave, be respectful of the holy water urn and votive candles located there. We've had a problem lately with children playing with the holy water, the matches

and candles, and even blowing out the candles that are lit in front of the image of the Divine Mercy. Also, please do not bring food or drink into the nave.

With that being said, I also ask all of you who do not have small children to be understanding with those who are trying to train their children to attend Mass quietly and reverently. Be courteous and allow them to sit close to the aisles and in the back pews in case they need to exit quickly with a fussy child. If we can all show a little patience and courtesy with one another, remembering that everyone wants to be able to participate in the Mass, it goes a long way in making St. Ann's the warm, friendly, and well-ordered parish that we all want it to be.

Lastly, please do not forget that 3 of our parishioners are being ordained as priests in the coming week! David Carter is being ordained as a priest for the Fraternal Society of St. Peter on Thursday, 28 May 2026, in Omaha, NE, while Peter Townsend and Robbie Bauman are being ordained as priests on Saturday, 30 May 2026, at St. Mark's in Huntersville. **Next Sunday's 10:30 am Mass will be the first Mass for the soon-to-be Fr. Peter Townsend, so it'll be a lot more crowded than normal.**

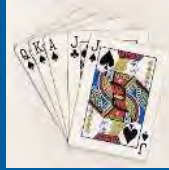



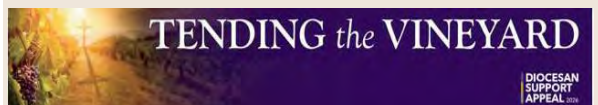
