Dear Parishioners,



It's been an incredible week for our parish as 3 of our members have been ordained to the Sacred Priesthood of Jesus Christ. Fr. David Carter was ordained for the Fraternal Society of St. Peter on Thursday in Omaha, Nebraska, while Frs. Robbie Bauman and Peter Townsend were ordained yesterday for our diocese. I was blessed to make it to Fr.

Carter's ordination and reception in Nebraska and still make it back in time for our diocesan ordinations.

As these three men begin their priestly ministry, I think it important for our parish to pray that God will bless and guide their priesthoods. It's not easy being a priest, especially these days, and we need all the prayers we can get. So, will you join me in offering this **Novena for Priests** beginning today and concluding on Monday, 08 June? Here's the novena prayer:

Jesus, Good Shepherd, You sent us the Holy Spirit to guide Your Church and lead her faithful to You through the ministry of Your priests.

Through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, grant to Your priests

As they cry out with all the faithful, 'Abba, Father!' may Your priests be ever more closely identified with You

in Your divine Sonship and offer their own lives with You, the one saving Victim.

*Make them helpful brothers of one another, and understanding fathers of all Your people.
Renew in Your priests deeper faith, greater trust in You, childlike reliance on our Mother Mary, and unwavering fidelity to the Holy Father and his bishops.*

Holy Mary, intercede for your priests.

St. Joseph, protect them.

St. Michael, defend them.

St. John Vianney, pray for them.

As Fr. Jones and I both prepare to celebrate the anniversary of our priestly ordinations this coming week (07 June for Fr. Jones and 05 June for me), I am acutely aware of how your prayers enable me to do all that I'm asked to do. Thank you for your earnest prayers – for all the Masses, rosaries, holy hours, and other prayers you've offered for me. I'm so very grateful.

Keep in mind that there's a plenary indulgence (under the usual conditions) for receiving a newly ordained priest's blessing. The custom is to kneel before the priest, receive his blessing, and then kiss his hands. Fr. Townsend will be offering a Mass of Thanksgiving today at 10:30am, and there will be a reception afterwards where he'll be available for blessings. Fr. Bauman will offer the 10:30am Mass here next Sunday and lead our Corpus Christi procession, while Fr. Carter will be offering a Mass of Thanksgiving at the Chapel of the Little Flower next Sunday at noon.



Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am. Registration is found online at the parish website.

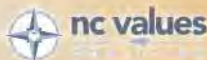
