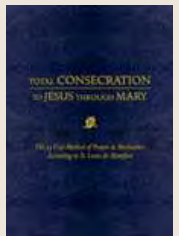
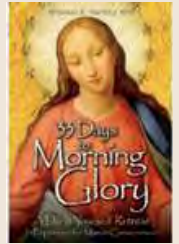

Dear Parishioners,



Tomorrow (July 13th) we begin our annual Marian Consecration preparation. You can use either Fr. Michael Gaitley's book: 33 Days to Morning Glory, or St. Louis de Montfort's True Devotion to Mary (just be sure to get a version with the consecration preparation included in the book). Then, following the Masses on August 15th, which is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (and the anniversary of our parish founding), those who have prepared will make the consecration to Mary. If you have made the consecration in the past, I encourage you to renew it every year. Countless saints

throughout our Church's history have encouraged the faithful to turn to Mary in their every need, and solemnly consecrating oneself to her is "the surest, easiest, shortest, and the most perfect means" to becoming a saint (St. Louis de Montfort).



I also hope many of you are praying daily the Litany of the Precious Blood, as I suggested in last Sunday's homily. My encouragement is to pray it every day this month (as July is the month dedicated to the Precious Blood) for the preservation of our country and its protection from the evil one. I also encourage you to pray this litany in reparation for sin, for protection of your family and our parish from evil, and for the Poor Souls in Purgatory. Copies of this litany are easily found online, and we have copies on the table by the baptismal font in the back of church.

Lastly, we are quickly coming up on our patronal feast day, which is July 26th. St. Ann is the patroness for grandmothers, for those trying to conceive a child, and for those looking for husbands. There's a great novena on the Hallow app for those who'd like to pray for St. Ann's intercession: <https://hallow.com/blog/st-anne-novena/#day-7> I encourage you to pray this 9-day novena beginning this Friday, July 18th.

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **The faith formation classes will begin again in September. Online registration is required in August.**

1st Communion Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for 1st Communion in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on September 9th at 7pm in the Café to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year.

Confirmation Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for Confirmation in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on September 16th at 7pm in the Café to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year. Note that your child must attend 2 years of instruction to be confirmed. Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am for 7th and 8th grade instruction. Registration is found online at the parish website.

Teen Apologetics: We meet on each of the Faith Formation Sundays from 9:00-10:10am between the Masses in the Allen Center. We are off for the summer so these classes will start back up in September. This class is for young people who have been confirmed through 12th grade. Invite a friend and join us!

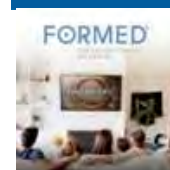

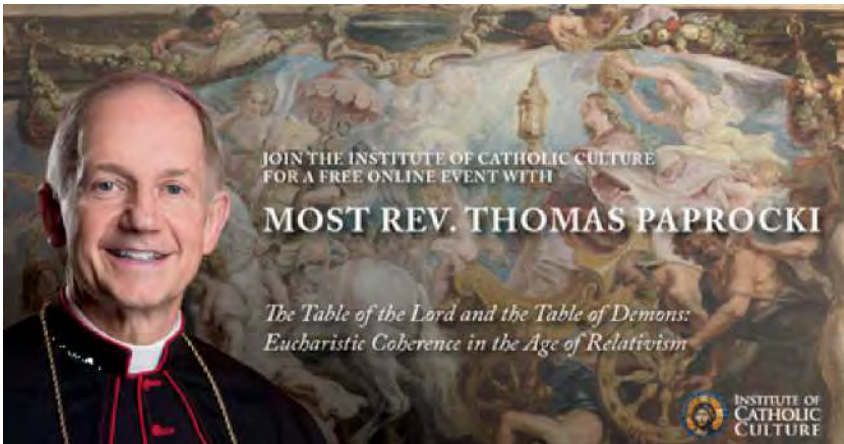
This devotion was given as an
