This weekend we are blessed to have Fr. Paul Check with us, a longtime friend of both Fr. Jones and me, while we are on our respective vacations. Fr. Check is a priest of the Diocese of Bridgeport, CT, but he currently serves on the faculty of the Pontifical College Josephinum, a seminary in Columbus, OH. In the past Fr. Check has served as the Executive Director of the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, WI, was a rector of a college seminary in Connecticut, and he served as the Executive Director of Courage International. Please welcome him warmly!

Many thanks to all our volunteers who helped with our Summer Catechesis program this past week. I'm especially grateful to our Faith Formation Director, Virginia Blatchford, and her assistant Isabella Ferrante, for all their hard work this past week.

This is a terrific program for our kids each year, and it takes a lot of effort to make it happen.

Our parish is blessed to have two young men entering St. Joseph College Seminary at the end of this month: Michael Grant and John Townsend (the younger brother of newly-ordained Fr. Peter Townsend). Michael and John both grew up serving as altar boys in our parish, and they'll enter seminary on Friday, 31 July. To pray for them, I encourage you go pray the following novena to St. John Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests and a patron saint of seminarians, beginning on 27 July and ending on 04 August (the feast day of St. John Vianney):

Faith Formation: The St. Ann Faith Formation program for the children of registered parishioners in grades K-8 takes place from 9:00 to 10:10am between the Masses on Sunday. **The faith formation classes will begin again in September. Online registration is required in August.**

1st Communion Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for 1st Communion in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on **September 9th at 7pm in the Café** to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year.

Confirmation Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for Confirmation in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on **September 16th at 7pm in the Café** to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year. Note that your child **must attend 2 years of instruction** to be confirmed. Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am for 7th and 8th grade instruction. Registration is found online at the parish website.

Teen Apologetics: We meet on each of the Faith Formation Sundays from 9:00-10:10am between the Masses in the Allen Center. We are off for the summer so these classes will start back up in September. This class is for young people who have been confirmed through 12th grade. Invite a friend and join us!
