This past Friday two young men from our parish, Michael Grant and John Townsend, entered St. Joseph College Seminary along with eight other men from around the diocese. There was a special Mass at Sacred Heart in Salisbury to mark the event. I hope that many of you are praying the novena to St. John Vianney for Michael and John leading up to St. John Vianney's feast day on August 4th that I put in last Sunday's bulletin:

O Saint John Vianney, patron of seminarians, you had to struggle against many barriers—including academic challenges—to become the esteemed priest that you were. Help our seminarians, Michael and John, in their struggles as they pattern their lives after our Heavenly Mother.

Inspire these men to consecrate their lives to God and ignite within them a deep zeal for souls. Guide them to remain resolute in their studies and faithful to prayer during their time of formation. 1st Communion Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for 1st Communion in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on **September 9th at 7pm in the Café** to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year.

Confirmation Parents for Fall: Save the date for a parent meeting for those who have a child that will prepare for Confirmation in the spring of 2027. Our team will meet with you on **September 16th at 7pm in the Café** to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year. Note that your child **must attend 2 years of instruction** to be confirmed. Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am for 7th and 8th grade instruction. Registration is found online at the parish website.

Teen Apologetics: We meet on each of the Faith Formation Sundays from 9:00-10:10am between the Masses in the Allen Center. We are off for the summer so these classes will start back up in September. This class is for young people who have been confirmed through 12th grade. Invite a friend and join us!
