And please treat the relic as you would the Eucharist by genuflecting before it.

Lastly, don't forget the annual **Parish Carnival**. This year the Carnival will take place on Saturday, 03 October 2026. 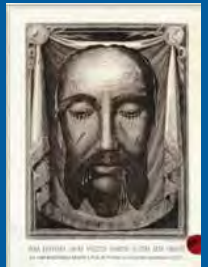

Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am for 7th and 8th grade instruction. Registration is found online at the parish website.

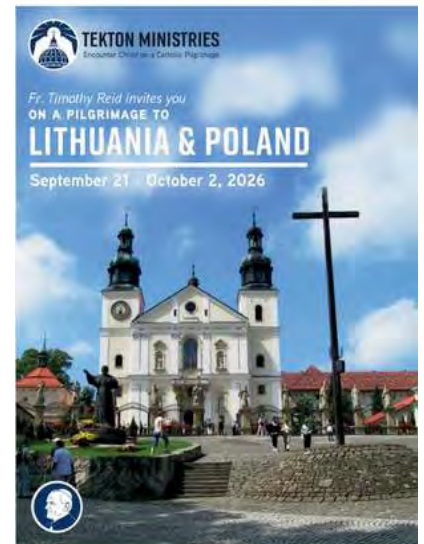

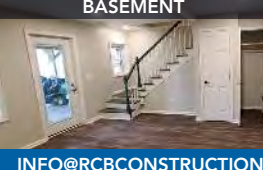
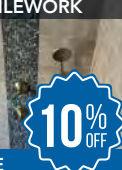




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
