Dear Parishioners,



Happy Labor Day weekend! Per the usual, I am visiting with my family this weekend. In my absence we have a missionary priest with us, Fr. Arul, to cover our Masses. Please welcome him warmly.

Many thanks to all our school families for using the new Mass check-in system. Let me give some explanation why we're using this system. More than 30 years ago when our local parish schools were amalgamated into Mecklenburg Area Catholic Schools, a tuition discount was offered for practicing Catholic families through subsidies given by the local parishes. Ever since this tuition discount for practicing Catholics was devised, parishes in Charlotte have been tracking the Mass attendance of Catholic school families through their use of offertory envelopes to ensure their practice of the Faith. However, as most families now

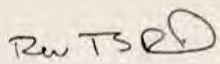
give to their parish offertory through online platforms, the envelope system used for tracking attendance for several decades has become obsolete.

Moreover, in the past when our parish was smaller and I knew almost all of our families, I generally had a good idea if a family was attending Mass or not. Now that the parish is double the size of what it was when I became pastor, there's no way I can keep up with all our school families. And again, as many people are no longer using the offertory envelopes, we had to find a new way to track attendance.

This new system was put together by my staff and I with an eye to making things as easy as possible for our parishioners, while ensuring some accountability for our families who are benefiting financially from our parish. Because of the hundreds of thousands of dollars St. Ann's is paying out in tuition assistance each year, I need to have a sense that school families are indeed qualifying for our subsidy as a matter of financial accountability. Sadly, we've had Catholic school families in the past who have gotten the practicing Catholic discount, but who really didn't practice the Faith by attending Mass regularly (and there have been times when I've revoked that discount because of this). As your pastor I am very happy for St. Ann's to partner with you in paying for your children's Catholic education, but I must also be a good steward of our parish resources while encouraging you to practice the Faith with integrity.

Although Catholic school families are piloting this program for us, we may expand it to other parishioners when we need to have some sense of Mass attendance (for example, when someone is new to the parish but asks for a letter stating they're a practicing Catholic). Thank you for your cooperation and your understanding.

Our team will meet with you on September 16th at 7pm in the Café to explain our program and your responsibilities for this sacramental year. Please bring a copy of your child's baptism certificate for their file. Note that your child must attend 2 years of instruction to be confirmed. Your 7th grade Catholic homeschool program or your 7th grade religion classes at Holy Trinity count as your year 1 of instruction. However, you must check in the program. If you have a public-school student preparing for confirmation, they must be enrolled in our Sunday faith formation classes which meet from 9-1010 am for 7th and 8th grade instruction. 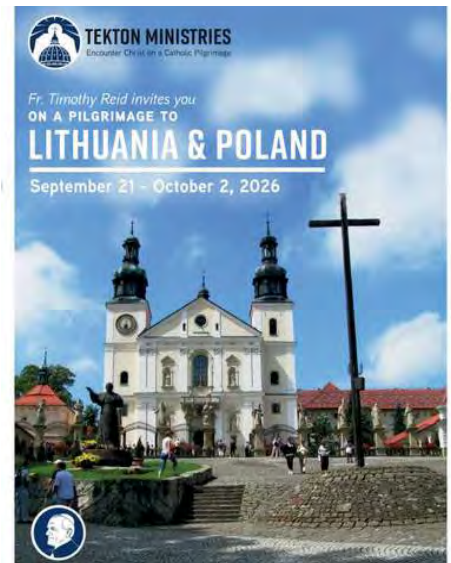

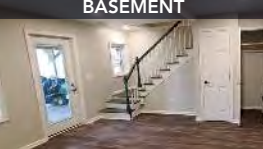
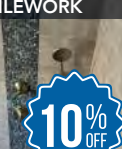
